- ▶ *Continuing Education Committee*  
Promote and support the development of programs for construction education at all levels of study.
- ▶ *Higher Education Liaison Committee*

- ▶ *Legal Advisory Committee*  
Provide a forum for attorneys and contractors to exchange information about construction industry issues.
- ▶ *Marketing/ Public Relations Committee*  
Develop and promote programs to improve the image of the industry and public awareness of the role of the general contractor and the Chapter.
- ▶ *Safety & Health Committee*  
Develop and maintain safety, health and environmental programs.
