## WHAT IS THE LEED AP BUILDING DESIGN + CONSTRUCTION CERTIFICATION?

Under LEED Version 3, the LEED AP credential will continue to signify an advanced depth of knowledge in green building practices; it also will reflect the ability to specialize in a particular LEED Rating System. The LEED AP exam is divided into two parts. The first part is the LEED Green Associate exam, which demonstrates general knowledge of green building practices. The second part is a specialty exam based on one of the LEED Rating Systems. Replacing the LEED AP for New Construction exam track, this specialty (LEED AP BD+C) provides a standard for professionals participating in the design and construction phases of high-performance, healthful, durable, affordable, and environmentally sound commercial, institutional, and high-rise residential buildings.

## ABOUT THE LEED GREEN ASSOCIATE COURSE

The single day intensive course provides an in-depth approach to the LEED Version 3 Rating System specific to Green Building Design and Construction and is designed to assist individuals in their preparation for GBCI's LEED AP credentialing exam. The program focuses on the essential concepts, technical requirements, design standards, case studies/lessons learned and a variety of other tools necessary for sustainable construction to comply with the LEED Green Building Rating System.

## WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

The course is for those individuals who have been *personally* involved with a project registered for LEED certification within the last three years and can show how they have contributed to the registered project through active participation in it and have on-going responsibility through their participation. It is also suggested that the participant wishing to pursue the AP+ credential have successfully completed the GA exam. In order to apply for the LEED AP credential, the individual must show how they have been exposed to the LEED process and have knowledge of the project. They can work in a variety of fashions that are linked to the project such as in an on-going, full-time role with the LEED Project team in multiple phases of the project including managing or leading the project design or construction team, or facility management teams by providing installation, supervision, auditing, consulting, managing or other leadership roles with the project team. This list is not meant to be exhaustive, but is meant to provide guidance for those who wish to apply for LEED AP status.

**Please note:** You do not have to take the LEED Green Associate (GA) exam prior to applying as a candidate for the LEED AP exam as the GA exam is the first part of the AP exam. However, we do recommend that you take the exams separately. If you apply as a candidate for the LEED AP exam and only pass one of the sections (GA or AP) you will not qualify as a GA or AP. You must pass both parts of the AP exam to receive your certification.
