Subject: Treasury Says MBT "Fixed" to Address Construction

Senate tax policy staff met with Karoub Associates on Friday afternoon and assured them that AGC's issues would be dealt with. This was followed by a report on Friday evening in MIRS indicating that the new Michigan Business Tax proposal will be amended to address AGC and construction industry concerns about the pyramiding of the gross receipts tax.

A Treasury spokesman said that the construction industry's concerns would be addressed before the proposal is made final. Anyway, it's very good news on a Monday and we look forward to seeing the legislative language.
