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AGC of Michigan Presents 2015 Outstanding Safety Performance Awards

Lansing, Mich. – In an ongoing effort to promote safety in the commercial construction industry, the Associated General Contractors (AGC) of Michigan presented its construction company members with 2015 Michigan Outstanding Safety Performance Awards during the AGC Annual Meeting today in Lansing.

“Construction will always be a dangerous business and the need for safety education, training and recognition is a focus of our association,” said AGC Chairman Jay Smith (The Christman Company, Lansing). “These awards recognize that AGC of Michigan contractor members take safety seriously and are among the industry’s leaders in protecting their company’s most valuable asset – their employees.”

These awards are based on lost work injury rates with zero being the best. Companies are grouped into divisions based on work hours generated during the award calendar year:

- Division I: Under 50,000 work hours
- Division II: Between 50,001- 100,000 work hours
- Division III: Between 100,001-300,000 work hours
- Division IV: Between 300,001-500,000 work hours
- Division V: Over 500,000 work hours

The award also are categorized by general contractor and specialty contractor. The award has three levels of achievement, gold, silver and bronze. The gold requires an injury rate of zero. The silver is an injury rate above zero, but not more than one and the bronze is an injury rate above one, but not more than two.
