**POWER OF ATTORNEY for ASSIGNMENT/AUTHORIZATION of

It is understood that the AGC is only acting as an agent. In no event shall the AGC be bound as principal or be held responsible for any breach of any contract by the undersigned. Furthermore, the undersigned Employer shall not become obliged to follow the designated collective bargaining agreement(s) for any period before the execution date of this document.
