**Contractors**

- ◇ Ask why the student picked construction management or civil engineering as a career.
- ◇ Talk about various positions within your company – not specifically the title, but the role and responsibility of each member of the team.
- ◇ Share your career path and talk about what it takes to move from one level to the next (skills, experiences, job types, job size, etc.)
- ◇ Give suggestions on what they should focus on in remaining school term(s).
