***AGC of Michigan raises over \$11,000 to support healthy sleeping habits***

**Farmington, Mich.**— The AGC of Michigan’s Construction Leadership Council hosted its 16th annual event in support of Sweet Dreamzzz, a non-profit organization committed to improving children’s health, wellbeing and academic performance by providing sleep education and bedtime essentials to economically disadvantaged students and their families on March 28, 2019. Just over \$11,000 was raised to support the mission of Sweet Dreamzzz, totaling \$93,000 + since between 2003 and 2019, at this year’s event hosted at John Cowley & Sons Irish Pub.

Sweet Dreamzzz’ sleep programs are taught to preschool through 5th grade children in a fun and interactive way with hands on games, songs and activities by trained sleep educators. Each child receives a Sweet Dreamzzz sleep kit containing a blanket or sleeping bag, nightshirt, toothbrush and toothpaste, a reading book and other bedtime items.

“Sweet Dreamzzz is grateful to have a strong partner like the AGC of Michigan and the Construction Leadership Council,” said Nancy Maxwell, executive director of Sweet Dreamzzz. “Their ongoing support has helped us set thousands of children up for success. Healthy sleep habits are important for everyone, but especially children as they develop.”
