



Competition Rules & Disclaimers

1. The Build Michigan competition is open to general contractors who are current members in good standing with the AGC Michigan. All projects entered must have reached substantial completion between November 1, 2023 and November 1, 2024. **The final submission deadline for project entries is 11:59 p.m. ET, Thursday, October 31, 2024.**
2. Each entry requires an entry fee of \$150 which directly helps fund the AGC Michigan Educational Endowment Fund for scholarships. Each category is one entry.
3. **ALL parties of a joint venture MUST be AGC member firms in good standing.**
4. Projects entered must be located in Michigan. Any projects with a fatality will be disqualified.
5. Nominations must be submitted by principals or officers of firms, or with their written permission.
6. Entries must include color photos. Photos should highlight the construction process and the finished project, including special techniques or unique conditions. Photos that are uploaded should be in JPG/JPEG or PNG format, ideally in 300 dpi resolution (for production purposes). Each file, including photos, may not exceed 5 MB.

Selected photos & video provided will be used in a video compilation of all entries which will be shown at Annual Meeting. Photos will also be included in the spring "Michigan Constructor" magazine and on the Chapter website.

7. All entries and accompanying materials will become the property of AGC Michigan upon submission. By submitting an entry, the entrant grants to AGC Michigan a broad, nonexclusive royalty-free license to copy, distribute, and otherwise use the entry and all accompanying materials (including materials in text, image, or other forms) in works both related and unrelated to the AGC Build Michigan Awards. The entrant warrants that it has the right to grant such a license and that neither the entry nor the license infringes on the rights of any third party. Do not submit any materials to which you do not have the copyright and other proprietary rights
8. You may also submit PDFs, Microsoft Word documents, or Microsoft Excel documents with your entry (press coverage, letters of commendation, programs from special events, etc.) A maximum of fifteen (15) uploaded files (including photos) are allowed per submission. Each file, regardless of type, may not exceed 5 MB. Do not submit multiple images within the same file.
9. The judges will consider awards for new construction and renovation work in the following categories:

Building Construction	Building Construction (\$10 million or less)
Federal & Heavy Construction	Construction Management
Design-Build	Environmental, Sustainable, LEED

Description of Categories:

Building Construction — Your completed project was a traditional building that may include office buildings, hospitals, schools, libraries, museums, multifamily housing and others. All project delivery systems apply.

Building Construction (\$10 million or less) — Same as above, but total completed project cost was under \$10 million.

Federal & Heavy—Your completed project was for the Corps of Engineers, NAVFAC, The Air Force, GSA; any type of marine construction or dredging projects for ports and inland waterways; flood control and prevention projects for the Natural Resources Conservation Service, Bureau of Reclamation and any industrial plant construction.

Construction Management—Your project was completed using the Construction Management project delivery system where your total percentage of volume of work performed with your own field personnel was under five percent.

Design-Build—Your project was completed using the Design-Build project delivery system.

Environmental—Your project included green building, wetland mitigation, ground water clean-up, reclaimed or remediated an environmentally contaminated site (e.g., brownfield, superfund, illegal dumping site, or abandoned mine).

NOTE:

If your project is not selected as a final winner, you are encouraged to refer to it in your marketing promotions as a “Build Michigan Award Nominee” and be proud that it was considered in a competitive field of the “best of the best”. Your project will also be featured in the spring issue of the Michigan Constructor magazine and area newspapers.
